Performance, Venue & Staging

- The venue for this performance is a working church. It is a large airy space with huge windows and white walls.
- Part of the audience will be seated around tables, whilst the other half of the audience will be in more traditional rows. The maximum capacity is 176 people.
- The performance will take place on a small stage in front of a large metal rood screen in the church, with the alter behind the actors.
- There are a small number of times where the actors will move through the audience.
- This performance starts at 2.30pm so the natural light from outdoors will illuminate the space. As it gets towards the end of the performance, the stage lighting will start to take effect.

The Cast

- There are three actors in this production, and they will play sixteen different characters.
- These are reflected through simple changes of costume such as a hat or coat.
- The actors will also modify their voices for each character.
